



## ***Procedure To Attain Level I Certified Status With Academy of Infrared training Inc.***

### ***Level I Thermographer***

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1. Successful completion of Level I Thermography training course.
2. Student must attain 70% on written, closed book exam.
3. A practical exam will be administered. The Instructor observes as students perform instrument functions and tests in class.
4. 50 hours of practical thermographic inspections. This must be confirmed in writing by supervisor or manager and signed on a company letter head.
5. Submission of a typical report from a single inspection, or better yet, from a variety of applications and inspections. This will be a bound into a report with **original** thermograms and real life pictures (**not photocopies**). Please email your report or mail a disc or CD-Rom of the report, as we prefer to keep an electronic file rather than paper. Obviously, if we receive the report electronically, the hard copy is not necessary. These reports will be kept on file and not returned. A complete report should include:
  - (i) An introduction - why the inspection was performed
  - (ii) How and when it was performed, comments, findings, etc.
  - (iii) A summary of the results and priorities if applicable
  - (iv) Submit 10-12 report pages complete with thermograms and corresponding real life pictures. **Disc or email** preferred.

**When above items are completed (must be completed within a 9 months period), certification will be issued. Certification Stamps and/or Photo ID Cards must be requested prior to certification.**
